Dear colleagues,

A Japanese proverb says "Vision without action is just dreaming, but action without vision is a nightmare".

I believe that leadership needs to be based on this symbiosis between vision and action, especially given the complex, changing environment we are living in. If you miss out one of the two, you will fail. I am really proud that EFI focuses on both. For example, we are leading in shaping the bioeconomy vision and providing new and critical thinking for action towards its realisation.

This year we have worked hard to continue reflecting on the bioeconomy and especially on what it means in terms of strategies, roadmaps and actions for different parts of Europe. I hope I can meet you in September in Sardinia during our Annual Conference where you will learn more about recent and future EFI developments and we will enjoy a very interesting Scientific Seminar on Forests interconnecting Sustainable Development Goals to action, plus many other surprises.
