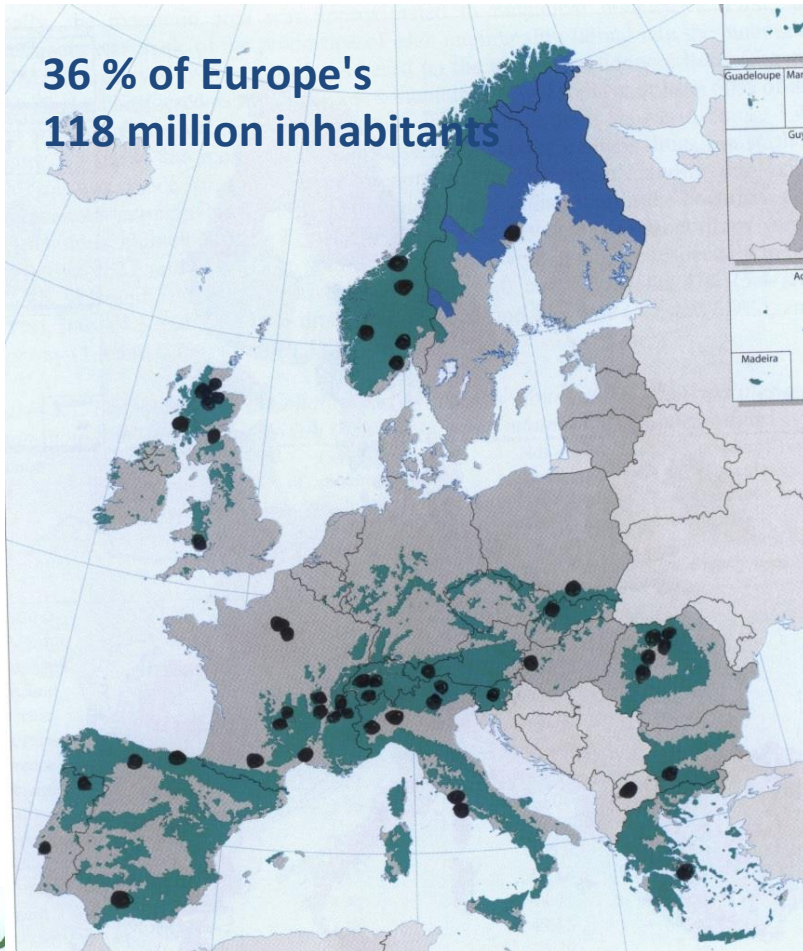

Euromontana's work on forestry

Study: “The utilisation of mountain wood and the organization of mountain wood industries”.

Recommendations based on six aspects of the development in the mountain forest sector:

- the integration of forestry project in regional dynamics ;
- financial support to the sector ;
- the role of marks and certifications ;
- the research of innovation and performance ;
- difficulties linked to accessibility and fragmentation ;
- the need to train stakeholders.
