




Rural Development Programmes (RDPs): Measure 16 Cooperation




Number of planned EIP Operational Groups in the 2014-2020 RDPs






State of play of the Operational Groups



- 600 Operational Groups funded RDP Measure 16 (March 2018)
- Forestry + Forestry related: 10% (DE, ES, FR, IT, IR,...)
- Topics covered:
 - Forest management, inventory
 - Forest products and services (wood and others)
 - Land management
 - Biodiversity, Nature conservation
 - Climate change, ecosystem services
 - Agroforestry (Silvipastoralism)
- Diversity of approaches on RDP: No "one fits all"
- Not supporting forestry Operational Groups: Greece, Sweden...




Moving forward: Lessons learnt and opportunities



- **The multi-actor approach works!** . End users (farmers, foresters, forest owners) <u>must</u> actually be involved throughout the project lifetime.
- Capitalising on projects' results. Spread out as widely as possible.
 - End users as first recipients. Further efforts should be made to reach out to them.
 - Adapt message and channels: Practice Abstracts, peer-to-peer learning....
 - Take advantage of the multipliers: H2020 Thematic networks, EIP AGRI,
 National Auth. (National/Regional Rural Network, national EIP AGRI).
- Get inspired and learn from other Operational Groups: brokerage events, databases



Moving forward: Lessons learnt and opportunities



- Towards more flexible and harmonised rules. e.g. cross-border cooperation
 - Cooperation out of the Operational Group
 - Cooperation within the Operational Group (partnership)








EIP AGRI Focus Groups:

Ideas for Operational Groups



FG mobilisation of forest biomass:

- Develop regional models and DSS for managing small-scale forests
- Develop models for virtual timber sales/marketing hubs
- Measures to raise awareness of forest owners about importance of their forests in providing ecosystem services

FG Agroforestry

- Test climate-smart agroforestry practices for ecosystem services at farm level
- Increase profitability through innovative value chains (e.g. wood or energy) and increased added value products (e.g. carbon storage labelling)
