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


Trends and drivers in services

1995 GATS ICT, Business services/KIBS (B2B, B2C)


Technology-enabled services, new service concepts and service innovations, Sustainability: Product-Service Systems New business models (C2B, C2C)

Resources, incl. labour and capital, knowledge and networks, have become available and connected in novel ways.



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


Changes in how value is created, distributed and captured:
