- 3. Introduction video:
  - length of maximum 60 seconds
  - must address:
    - short introduction of the candidate
    - topic of presentation/research
    - main points to be addressed during presentation
    - motivation for participation in the event
  - format must be .mp4 or .mov
  - resolution must be 720p HD at 30 fps
  - file size must not exceed 100 MB
