#	Question	Answer
1.	Regarding Eligibility as a Legal Entity (Legal person): The call specifies that the applicant must be a legal entity (legal person). As a registered freelancer operating as a legal entity in Spain, would my status meet the criteria for application?	Pre-assessment of a potential applicant in respect of meeting the eligibility criteria is not possible. All eligibility criteria can be found in the <a href="#">grant submission guidelines</a> .
2.	Regarding Registration Time Requirements: If I decide to register myself instead as a freelance, as a business legal entity, are there any specific time requirements that the entity needs to be established before being eligible for the grant application?	By the deadline for submission of the application, all eligibility criteria must be fulfilled.
3.	I'm an assistant professor. So, I'm a legal person. - Is that possible for me to apply for the grant (G-06-2023)?	This call is not open for applications from natural persons. You can find all eligibility criteria in the <a href="#">grant submission guidelines</a> .
4.	If our work plan will be accepted, will the grant be paid to Institute or to project manager?	The grant will be awarded to the legal entity.
